

## General Safety



The company premises of Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH are **not open to the public**.  
The German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) apply on the company premises and in the entire port area, as well as the requirement **to drive on the right!**  
Industrial trucks and rail traffic always have priority.



Driving on the premises is **at your own risk**.  
Special care must be taken around cranes and helmets must be worn.  
Standing under suspended loads is **strictly prohibited**.



Life jackets must be worn if you are **less than 2 meters** from the quayside!  
It is mandatory to wear high-visibility clothing when leaving vehicles or buildings.  
There is a general prohibition on the **consumption of alcohol, drugs or other intoxicating substances**.



There is an absolute ban on **all types of weapons, firearms, cutting and thrusting weapons and other dangerous objects** on the entire company premises!  
Smoking, fire and naked flames are prohibited in the entire port area.



There is a **risk of slipping and tripping** in the entire port area. (Rail tracks, uneven surfaces, etc.).  
There is a risk of falling into the water when standing on the quayside.



A maximum **speed limit of 30 km/h** applies on the entire premises. Vehicles must drive at walking speed around buildings and on combined paths. Vehicles may only **be parked in designated parking areas**. Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH reserves the right to have vehicles removed for a fee if they are parked contrary to instructions, obstruct terminal operations or pose any other risk.



**No photos or videos** may be taken within the port area. All types of misuse will be prosecuted. The **use of a multicopter** (drone) requires prior approval from FHS GmbH.

Every person must register before entering the ISPS area. **Access authorization** is granted on a personal basis only and cannot be transferred or extended. If persons are taken along in vehicles, **all individual occupants** are subject to the registration requirement.

Each vehicle must independently trigger the barrier opening at the ISPS terminal. **Driving in behind vehicles in front is an access violation** and will be prosecuted. Violations of the above regulations can and will result in a prohibition of entry!

## First aid, fire protection, escape and rescue routes



In the event of danger, please go to the **assembly point** in front of the buildings.  
In the event of an accident or injury, please speak to the nearest member of staff or call the **emergency services on 112**



The first aid facilities are located in buildings, among other places, and are marked with corresponding symbol boards.



Escape plans and instructions must be followed.  
Keep **traffic routes, escape and rescue routes** clear at all times.  
Do not block or obstruct any emergency exits.

## Safety Signs



Please observe the signs indicating hazards, prohibitions and instructions as well as rescue facilities:



- Blue **mandatory signs** prescribe certain behavior, e.g. wearing hearing protection.
- Red prohibition signs prohibit behavior that may cause a hazard, e.g. smoking.
- Yellow **warning signs** warn of a risk or danger, e.g. Forklifts
- Green **escape signs** indicate an escape route or emergency exits, the route to a first aid facility or the first aid facility itself.
- Red **fire safety signs** indicate the location of fire alarms and fire extinguishing equipment.
- **Hazard symbols** indicate a hazard characteristic of a hazardous substance, e.g. toxic. Only instructed persons or guided groups are allowed in areas with hazardous substances.



## Environmental protection and disposal



**Avoid any environmental pollution** caused by waste or operating and hazardous materials. Please contact the nearest employee or Port Security if you notice anything unusual.

Please use the garbage cans provided for household and non-industrial waste. Any **unannounced disposal of industrial waste will be prosecuted** and reported.

The introduction of hazardous substances into the port area requires prior **written notification to the Hazardous Substances Officer**



## ISPS – Safety Area

Access is **exclusively** by prior application to the FHS

All Applications can only be submitted online at [isps@mukran-port.de](mailto:isps@mukran-port.de)

Requests must be submitted at least 24 hours before arrival.

All requests will be checked and approved by the PFSO..

The **“general safety instructions”** on page 1 must be observed!

The **costs** incurred **for the registration** will be borne by the company listed on page 3 in accordance with the valid tariff regulations of Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH

**In the event of loss or non-return**, costs will be charged in accordance with the valid tariff regulations of Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH. This also includes costs for unreturned access cards and personal protective equipment. Violations of the above provisions can and will result in a prohibition of entry!

## Summary

**Visitors and external companies are only granted access to the company premises under the following conditions**

1. Access permission is only granted after approval by the security personnel. **There is no general right of access** for visitors and external companies for terminals or for ships at the berths.
2. Each vehicle must independently trigger the barrier opening at the facilities. **Driving in behind vehicles in front is an access violation and will be prosecuted!**
3. **Access authorization** is only granted **to individuals** and **cannot** be transferred or extended. If persons are taken along in vehicles, **all individual occupants are subject to the obligation to register.**
4. The wearing of helmets and high-visibility vests is mandatory in some areas; these can be borrowed from the security staff if required on presentation of an identity card or driving license.
5. Unauthorized access to parts of the site, areas, buildings or facilities is strictly prohibited.
6. The preparation of video or audio recordings is prohibited in the entire port area. This also includes the use of multicopters (drones).
7. The instructions of the port personnel **must be followed.**
8. In the event of loss or non-return, costs will be charged in accordance with the valid tariff regulations of Fährhafen Sassnitz GmbH. This also includes costs for personal protective equipment not returned. Violations of the above provisions can and will result in a prohibition of entry!
9. acceptance of the regulations listed on the instruction sheet confirmed by signature.
